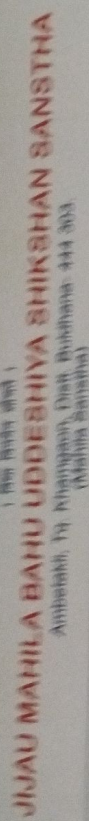

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1. EDUCATIONAL AND LITERACY PROGRAMME :

Considering very high level of child illiteracy the society has started with the help of the volunteers organizing boys and girls education programme on regular basis of District.

Considering the huge success an organizing these programme the society has continuously been distributing necessary book free of cost to the participants of this programme. The participants of this programme were benefited largely and the parents of the participating children were agreed to encourage other to join these programme aimed at welfare of the masses.

2. CHILD HEALTH CARE AWARENESS PROGRAMME :

An awareness generation programme aimed at making aware from about their health needs and nutrition was organized by the society. This programme was organized by the rural women in large number and it was felt by the attendant that this kind of programme are very useful in our villages where women were aware about their health needs a very low.

Further they were informed about various kinds of schemes formed and executed by the different Govt. Departments for welfare of the women either it is in education employment or technical guidance etc.

The women participating in the programme were informed about need for education in the self reliance of the women. They released the need for education and agreed to send their children particularly the girls child to school. Further, it was resolved that the society will further organized similar programme in the near future.

3. VOCATIONAL AND HANDICRAFT TRAINING PROGRAMME :

Keeping in the mind the objective of removal of poverty by reducing the problem of employment the society has been instrumental in taking various concrete steps in the direction of removal of poverty. Society has started a vocational training programme woman and youth are provided training in the different field like screen printing training programme, beauty parlor training programme, computer training programme, knitting and tailoring, chicken embroidery, secretarial practice training programme, typing and shorthand, food processing, readymade garments and fashion designing etc. by experience trainers. In this center trainees are provided training in the field of manual arts known as handicraft. The main aim of this programme is to make the trainees so skilled that they may become self dependent and stand on their own feet.

4. DRUG DE-ADDICTION AWARENESS PROGRAMME :

The society has been conducting camps aimed at raising awareness about the bad effects of the alcoholism and drinking. the Volunteers of the society went into the villages to raise consciousness about the effects of smoking and drinking and use of tobacco. Help of posters and banners was taken to make the presentation.

5. **FAMILY PLANNING AWARENESS CAMP** :

The population of our country surpassed 100 crores. This over population eats into all the development processes, lack of resources, food, job, health care facilities, schools and thousands of other problems owe their origins to this over population. The awareness about the benefits of having a very small family is still very low in our country particularly in the areas of the Capital of Maharashtra where the population density in disproportionately high.

Considering very high level of reluctance on part of the villages to adapt the family planning method the population explosion has taken place. Causing deterioration in the available sources like food, Education, Housing, and Employment etc. A camp was organized by the society at block of district to raise awareness about the bad effects of the disproportionate growth in the population. Help of audiovisual techniques was taken to make the presentation more effective. At the end of the camp condoms and contraceptive pills were distributed among the villages.

6. **PROGRAMME ON NATIONAL INTEGRATION** :

The programme on National Integration was organized by the society to arouse the feeling of Patriotism and always ready to help the human kind and any where at any time

7. **CONSUMER WELFARE PROGRAMME** :

A consumer awareness camp was organized to make them aware of the rights available under the consumer protection act. 1986. The programme was highly appreciated by the attendants of the programme. It is generally found that consumers, despite of paying competitive prices are offered low quality product by the companies. Through the products are packed

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in very attractive packages but, their quality happens to be very low. This may consumers get cheated every day by the producers and sellers. This situation is not too different in the cases of services also. The attendants of the programme were explained various remedies available to them under the consumer protection Act, 1986 and the rules and procedures for filing the suit way and manner of filling the appeals. Further, they were given names and addresses of different consumer associations whom they can contact in case of need.

8. WOMEN WELFARE AND COUNSELING CENTRE

To help the women society established a short stay home and family counseling center in different areas of district to settled the needy women on temporary basis and tier to help by solving their problems that they become able to settled in their family again and become self dependant.

9. CHILD / WOMEN LABOUR WELFARE PROGRAMME

A programme on women and child labour was organized by the society on labour Day at District. In this programme the volunteers aware the public about the women / child labour and told them about labor act to the participants.

The NGO's and the member of the society told about the fundamental rights of the women and also ask educate all the women in rural and urban areas to stand face a problem, which always happens in their lives time to time.
